

How to place your recycling cart for collection

Place your cart - with the back wheels towards the fence or property, close lid.

Point your cart - the cart lid opens towards the centre of the road or lane.

Space your cart - leave one arm's length clearance (one meter or 39 inches) on all sides of each cart. This is to allow the collection truck enough room to grab your cart.

Look up - avoid placing your cart under hydro or telephone wires, basketball hoops, awnings and tree limbs.

In Winter - clear snow away from the area around and under where you place your cart. Do not place carts behind or on top of snowbanks; clear snow and ice off lids so they will open easily when emptied.



Unacceptable items

These items require alternative handling.

These items are NOT accepted with your recycling.



Napkins, paper towels and food soiled cardboard – these can go in your personal composter.



Textiles and other items that can be re-used.



Plastic items not labeled #1-7 or large plastic products.



Diapers and personal hygiene products.



Ceramics, glassware and housewares.



Hazardous waste, sharps and electronics.



Scrap metal, wires and cables, home and construction waste.



Organic, kitchen, yard and animal waste.
